



Skaftfell – Austurvegur 42

Skaftfell is one of the oldest houses in Seyðisfjörður, built in 1907. It was donated by local artist Garðar Eymundsson in 1998 to establish the Skaftfell Center for Visual Art. Today the building on Austurvegur 42 houses the art center's gallery and bookstore on the first floor, the artist apartment on the top floor, and the bistro and art library on the ground floor.

The artist apartment contains: two bedrooms, working/living area (circa 25 m²), small kitchen, dish washer, bathroom with shower, washing machine, several work tables, 2 extra single beds if needed.

Residency fee: 105,000 ISK per month for a single artist, or 75,000 ISK per month/person for two artists sharing the apartment.
